All the Deputy Educational Officers/Mandala Educational Officers and Deputy Inspector of Schools in the district are informed that the Director, SCERT, A.P., Amaravathi has decided that the Gnana Dhaara Learning Enhancement Program shall be launched with a Baseline Test to identify students of Class VI, VII and VIII requiring remediation in the subjects of Telugu, English and Mathematics.

Further, they are informed that to conduct Base line Test on 31.10.2018 in all MPUPS,ZPHS,GHS and KGBVS and also instructed to communicate the following guidelines to all Headmasters of MPUPS,ZPHS,GHS and KGBVS in their respective districts.

- 1. The Baseline Test booklet consists of three subjects: Telugu, English and Mathematics.
- 2. Each of these subjects are divided into 4 sections (ABCD) and the total marks per subject are 30. The total marks for all 3 subjects put together is 90.
- 3. Class Teachers must administer the Baseline Test in their classrooms starting from 10 AM on the 31st of October.
- 4. Though all the three subjects question papers have been combined in one booklet, it is the responsibility of the subject teachers concerned to evaluate their respective subjects.
- 5. Marks scored must be noted in the table given at the top of the question paper.
- 6. The evaluated Baseline Test booklets must be submitted to the Headmaster for data entry in the CCE portal Data entry must be completed by the 5th of November. The details of the portal shall be intimated later,
- 7. Remedial students shall be identified by SCERT on the basis of the marks entered in the portal.

Therefore, All the Deputy Educational Officers in the district are requested to note that the baseline test booklets shall reach the respective Divisional points

by 27the October and the same will be collected from the Divisional points by the concerned Inspecting Officers and supplied school points by the 29^{th} October .

In view of the above, All the Deputy Educational Officers/Mandala Educational Officers and Deputy Inspector of Schools in the district are instructed to issued necessary instructions to all the Headmasters of MPUPS, ZPHS, GHS and KGBVS in their jurisdiction and the baseline test must be administered to all the students of Class VI, VII and VIII on the 31st of October without fail.

All the Deputy Educational Officers/Mandala Educational Officers and Deputy Inspector of Schools in the district are requested to furnish the class wise indent of Urdu Medium students of classes 6th to 8th by 5 PM on 25.10.2018 through email in the prescribed proforma.
